This block of Cabernet Franc vines lies along a fault line, and is known for the quartz-rich boulders that percolate up through the soil. The 2022 vintage includes a small amount of Malbec grown from the same small block of vines.

TASTING NOTE

Integrated aromas of pie cherry, nutmeg, and "Livermore Valley garrigue," reminiscent of the sage brush and grasses of our growing region. You can also find suggestions of raspberry, juniper and mocha. This continues through the bone dry palate, where hints of Turkish coffee, bay leaf, and blackcurrant lead into a black cherry finish. A trifecta of high acidity, tannins and silty texture point to great cellar-worthiness.
