For over a decade, the Kent family have produced their iconic rosé from malbec grapes, which create a vibrant rosé with a consistent “watermelon” profile from the lightest touch on the press. No green notes here!

100% of the grapes were estate grown. The Kent family's gentle attention to detail in the vineyard is matched by Julian Halasz's masterful winemaking.



For over ten years, proceeds from this wine have been given to fund breast cancer treatment and healthcare for local women in need, via Axis Medical Care.

TASTING NOTE

The 2024 vintage keeps an air of mystery about it, especially on the nose. An opening trace of minerality, even salinity, expands into notes of white grapefruit, white cranberry, and lingonberry. But take a sip, and the 2024 stops being so shy. The fruit-forward palate bursts with notes of watermelon candy, Santa Claus melon, and ripe strawberry.
