LIVERMORE VALLEY, CALIFORNIA

Blazing sun. Steep slopes. Lots of clay. Not much soil. Lone Hill is perfect for growing Clone 30 Cabernet Sauvignon, one of California's most distinctive and colorful heritage grapes.

The east and west side of Lone Hill are each a little different, with the fruit on the west side containing more pyrazines than any other Cab grown on the estate. Pyrazines are what make a 'sauvignon "savage,"' creating peppery and spicy notes.

100% of the grapes were estate grown. The Kent family's gentle attention to detail in the vineyard is matched by Julian Halasz's masterful winemaking.

TASTING NOTE

In the 2021, notes of ancho chili and Spanish paprika join plum and cinnamon aromatics. On the palate, flavors of fruit leather, savory plum, all-spice and sweet tobacco situate themselves in a mesh of fine, integrated tannins. With a full body and a strong backbone of acidity, this wine will continue to cellar well through 2034. It already lingers long in the glass: Darcie loved the black raspberry finish.
