Wine Without Borders strives to grow the world's most interesting wines, despite these varietals not being household names.

The Kent family grows the acid-driven "Bari" clone of Zinfandel, aka Primitivo, in a small block that borders their home. They also harvest the varietal much earlier than is typical of California Zinfandel, just like Apulian winemakers. The result is a wine that has both dark fruit flavors and bright, food-friendly acidity.

The Kent family's gentle attention to detail in the vineyard, combined with Julian Halasz's masterful winemaking, creates a wine that reflects our true-to-terroir winemaking philosophy.
